# BOOKING for EXTRA ACTIVITIES



### TO BOOK - all 'Extra' activities (p.3-4) must be booked via the Parent Portal, as below:

In the Portal, click on the SOCS option in the right hand menu blocks.

Select your child, then view and select the options they would like from the available categories.

Click 'add' to see full details, then press the blue 'Add Activity' to book.

NOTE: If you try to book for multiple clubs in the same timeslot, a red 'clash notification' will appear.

#### **NOTES**

- **Additional Swimming** children should be confident in the water and able to swim at least 1 width unaided, on front and back.
- **Development & Fitness Swimming** to book, children MUST be able to swim front crawl, back crawl and breaststroke for at least one full length.
- Evening activities do not take place on exeat Fridays
